WEST VIEW / ARTHINGTON LANE JUNCTION - tree on grass verge at junction needs pruning.

ARTHINGTON LANE - self seeded trees are still requiring attention (previously brought to LCC's attention). 30 mph repeater signs covered by overgrown trees on stretch between Warren Lane and the Village Hall, as is the sign to Weardley from Arthington towards Harewood. Overgrown brambles on the left pavement from the pub towards Warren Lane.

BEDLAM LANE - still has potholes that require attention but not as bad as in previous years.

CRESKELD LANE - potholes on lower half, on approach to the narrow, windy section.

BLACK HILL LANE - grass by the bench at the foot of the hill needs trimming.
