3.24 Annual Report from Chairman

Cllr Lister reported that there had been three Parish Council meetings, all held at the Village Hall. The Spring Clean took place on 12th April and was well attended. Thanks are given to the Village Hall Committee for the refreshments.

The Precept was increased from £3,075 to £3,382 in part to cover the cost of a new email system.

Throughout the year the Parish Council has commented on several planning applications.

Thankfully crime is still low in the Parish, we are undated regularly by the Adel/Wharfedale Neighbourhood Policing Team.

The refurbishment of the telephone box is still ongoing and a second Speed Indicator Device was installed. The Parish Council also gave a £500 grant to the village cricket club who have done much work updating the cricket ground and pavilion. The ARAGE money is still invested in the Skipton Building Society.

In other news, roads and footpaths are due for repair next year and the Wharfedale pub has now been sold.

I attended the Remembrance service at Pool as usual.

My thanks to Margaret, our Clerk, all Councillors especially Cllr Fox for their planning expertise and Cllr Billy Flynn for all his advice over the last year.
